

Why Not Same-Sex “Marriage”? — 3-Point Leaflet

1) It is a con job, a rip-off, codology.

Only 0.3% of the population will avail of it if it is legislated for. It lasts on average 1.5 to 3 years. It takes a man and a woman to produce a child, not two men nor two women. Same-sex marriage doesn't include a promise of faithfulness. It doesn't include a promise of life-long commitment. Often same-sex “married” partners don't even live together. Humans are not made for such short-termism. The European Court of Human Rights has ruled that Finland is not in breach of the European Convention on Human Rights for not allowing same-sex “marriage”; that that Convention actually enshrines the concept of marriage as being between one man and one woman; and that there is no European consensus in favour of same-sex “marriage”, as only 13 of the 27 EU states permit it. 13 of the 47 states of the Council of Europe, permit it. Only about 20 countries of the 200 listed in the CIA World Factbook permit it, or 20 of the 192 in the UN.

2) It is misplaced compassion to vote for same-sex “marriage”. It is dangerous to the health and life of homosexual persons; it is not in the best interests of children to be adopted by same-sex couples, as it puts them in harm's way.

In their heart of hearts most people are against same-sex “marriage”. They know that active homosexual persons are at much greater risk of HIV, that they are at much greater risk of cancers, that they contract them earlier in life, and that their life expectancy is 20 years less than average. People also know deep down that a child is safer with a married man and woman, the child's own parents preferably, where both are alive. A child needs a good moral and safe environment, along with stability, not a major disruption every 1.5 to 3 years.

3) Persecution to follow, severe limitation on freedom of opinion and religion; ultimately the abolition of marriage.

If legislated for, same-sex “marriage” will be followed by legislation persecuting those who don't agree with it, and severely limiting their freedom of opinion and religion. That has already started in Northern Ireland, Canada, the U.S., Scandinavia, England, and Scotland. The ultimate aim is to abolish marriage altogether, a nightmare scenario.
